Metrics

- Toilet seats to be emptied every 7 days (830 visits)
- 40 seats yield 10m³ of waste / 7 days
- Composting shelters are built for 40m³ of waste
- It therefore takes 4 weeks to fill in one shelter. The shelter is then locked and left for 3 months for maturation.
- Meanwhile, shelters 2,3 and 4 are used.
- After 3 months, shelter 1 is emptied and used again.
- The same applies for the other shelters.

Cholera hit Haiti in the Fall of 2010. SAO and EAF created a compost toilet plan for all of Haiti. The first set of five toilet centres were celebrated on November 11th 2011 in an inauguration party in Limonade. A separate composting site will produce fertiliser for food production.
